## TORAH COMES ALIVE

Using a variety of modalities including music, art, storytelling, meditation, and drama, our fun and engaging classes will deepen students' connections to the rhythms of Jewish life and the cycles of the seasons. Students will explore the spiritual side of Judaism through direct experiences with meditation, chant, and contemplative practices. Together we will engage in mitzvah projects that allow us to put our values into action and collaborate in building *tikkun olam* (repair of the world).

Classes focus on specific themes that rotate each year. Basic Hebrew skills (decoding, simple vocabulary, prayers) are taught every year. Other themes include Torah stories, the Jewish calendar and holidays, Shabbat, prayers and blessings, mitzvot, and Jewish values. Students who return year after year will develop a strong foundation on which to build their future participation in the community through adolescence and into adulthood.

## FAMILY INVOLVEMENT

The strength of the CHL community is built on the active participation of individuals and families. Families enrolled in the Torat HaLev school are encouraged to become active participants in community programs, attend events like Shabbat services and holiday programs, and help in the larger community. By doing so we help strengthen the community and model for our children the mitzvah of *avodah* (work that contributes to the greater good).

Our school runs on a Family Education Model, and we encourage parents and family presence at every school session. **Parents at the THL school are expected to attend at least half the classes with their children each semester.** While we would love parents to attend every class session, we recognize that this is simply not possible for every family. **Parents who are unable to attend at least half the sessions agree to contribute a comparable number of volunteer hours in *avodah* service to the community.** This can take the form of things like helping at events, working in the CHL office, supervising children during services, and organizing.

For children with special needs or those who require more one-on-one attention, the expectation is that parents will attend classes with their children or send another adult to fulfill this role. For any sessions when no dedicated adult is able to attend, the parent must designate another class parent who will be present that day to serve as their child's adult. In this way we guarantee that the classroom remains a comfortable environment for productive learning for all students.

## PROGRAM DETAILS

Classes meet on Tuesday afternoons from 3:45 – 5:45 p.m. at Chochmat Ha Lev, 2215 Prince St. in Berkeley. The school year runs from September 2010 until April 2011 (see back for schedule).
